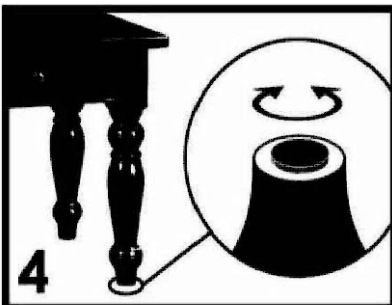
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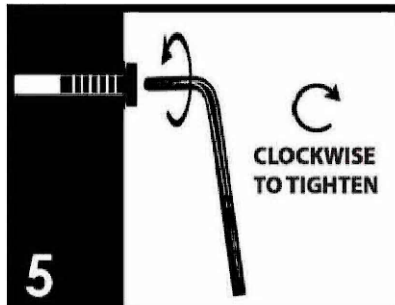
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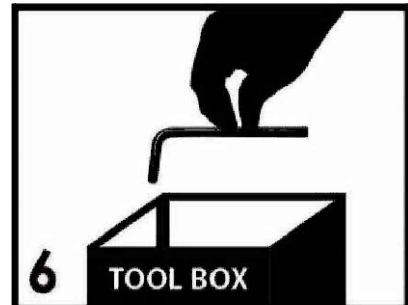
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Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



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Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.

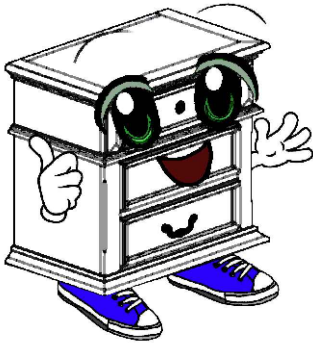

2) Attach dowels (#A) to the holes of the HB legs (#2R/L), then align shelves (#3,4,6) to the holes of the HB legs (#2R/L), then secure by using bolts (#C).

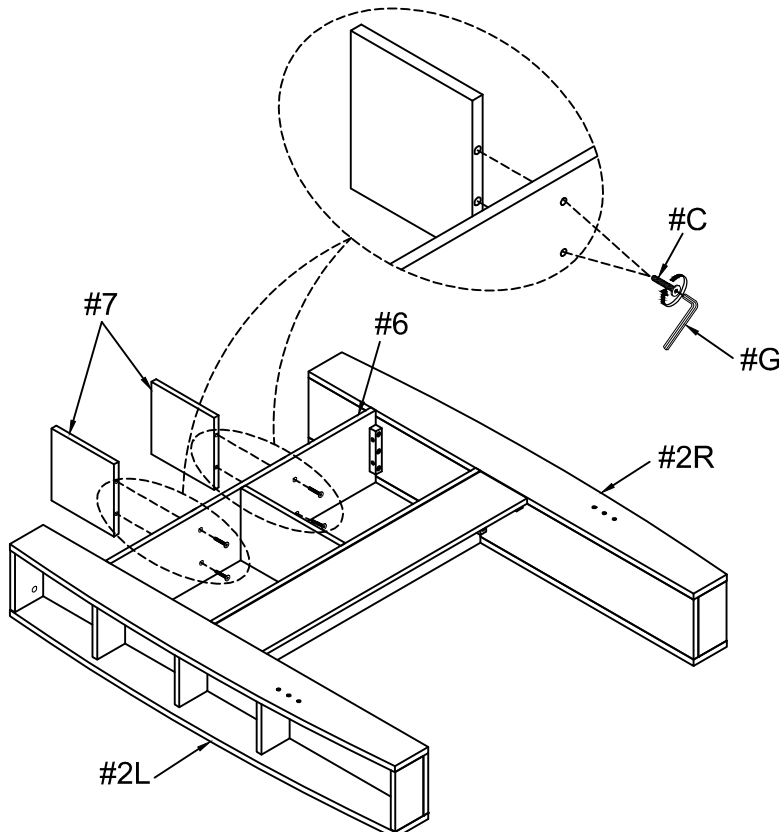


1) Attach dowels (#A) to the holes of the bottom panel (#5), then align and attach dowel holes of upper shelf (#6) to the dowels (#A) of bottom panel (#5).

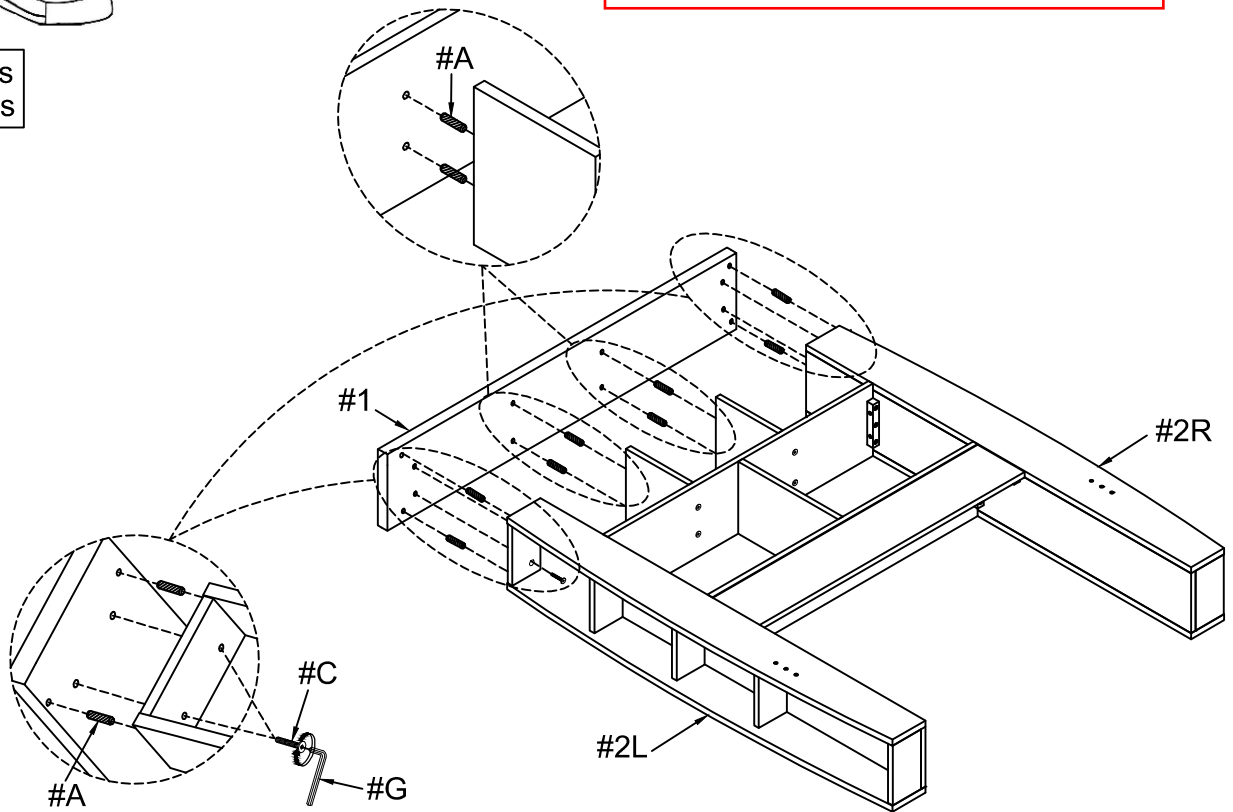
Align upper panel (#7) to the holes of the upper shelf (#6). Secure by using bolts (#C).





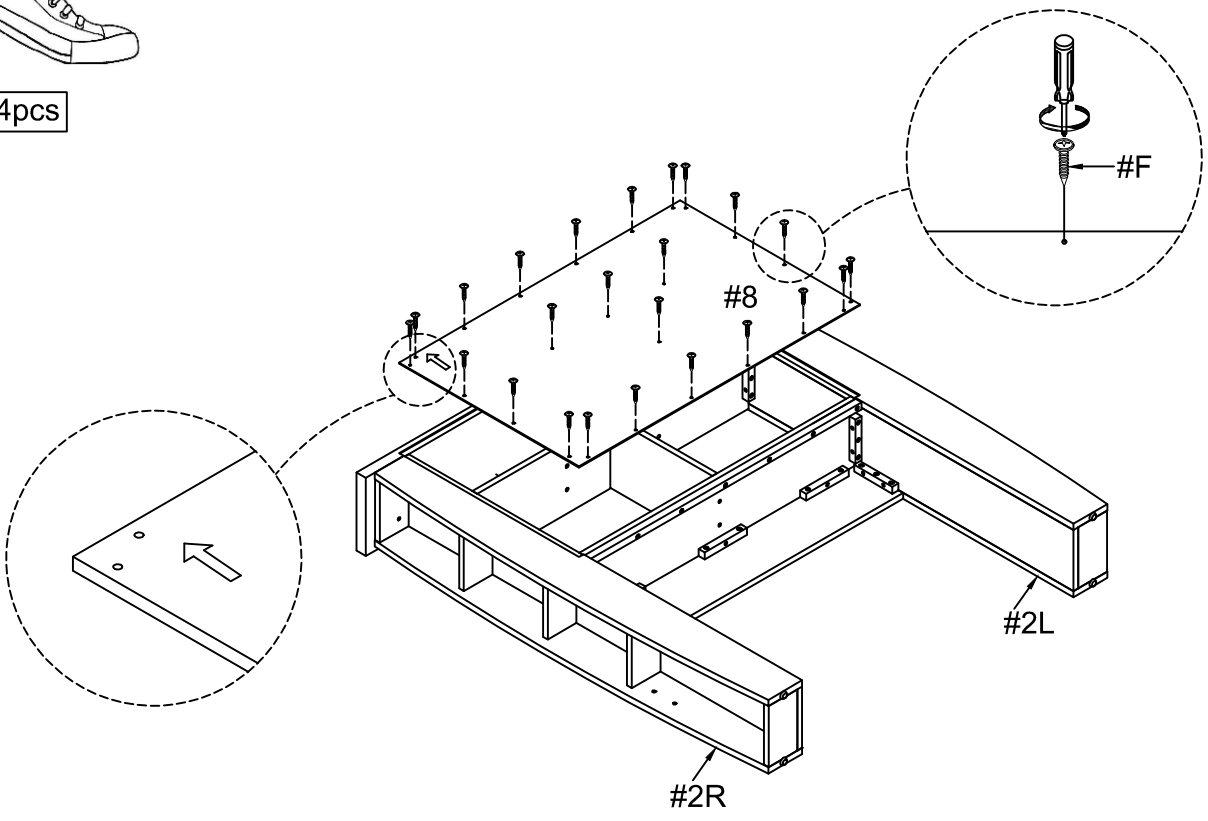
Attach dowels (#A) to the holes of headboard top panel (#1), then align top panel (#1) to the holes of the headboard base. Secure by using bolts (#C).

Align back panel (#8) to the back of the headboard. Secure by using screws (#F).

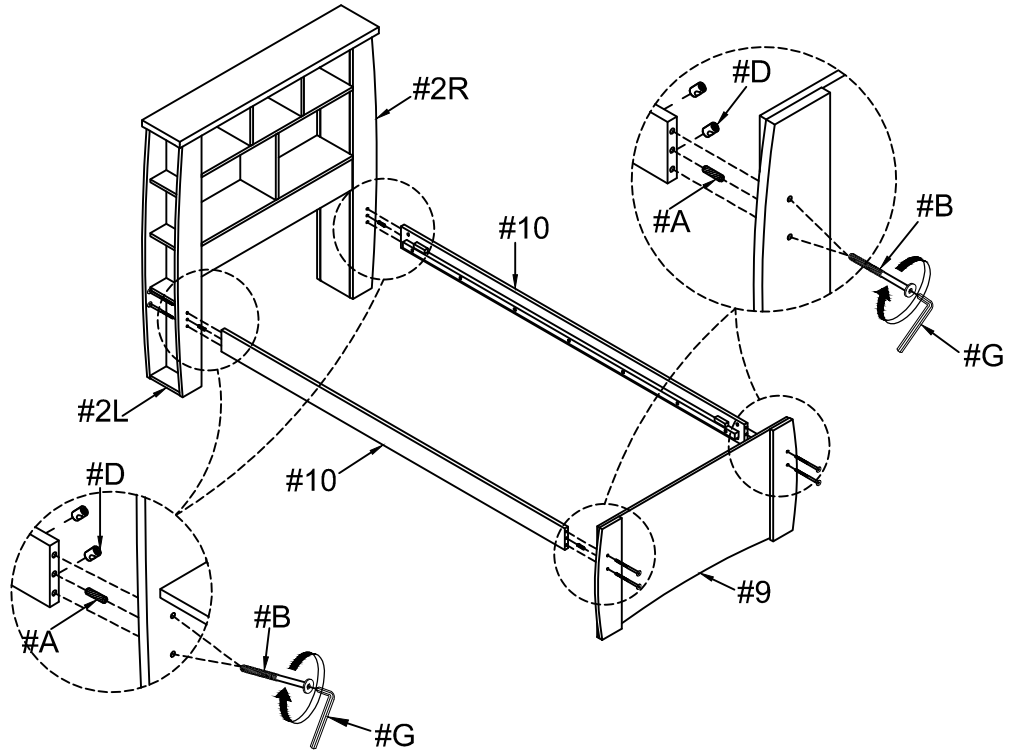

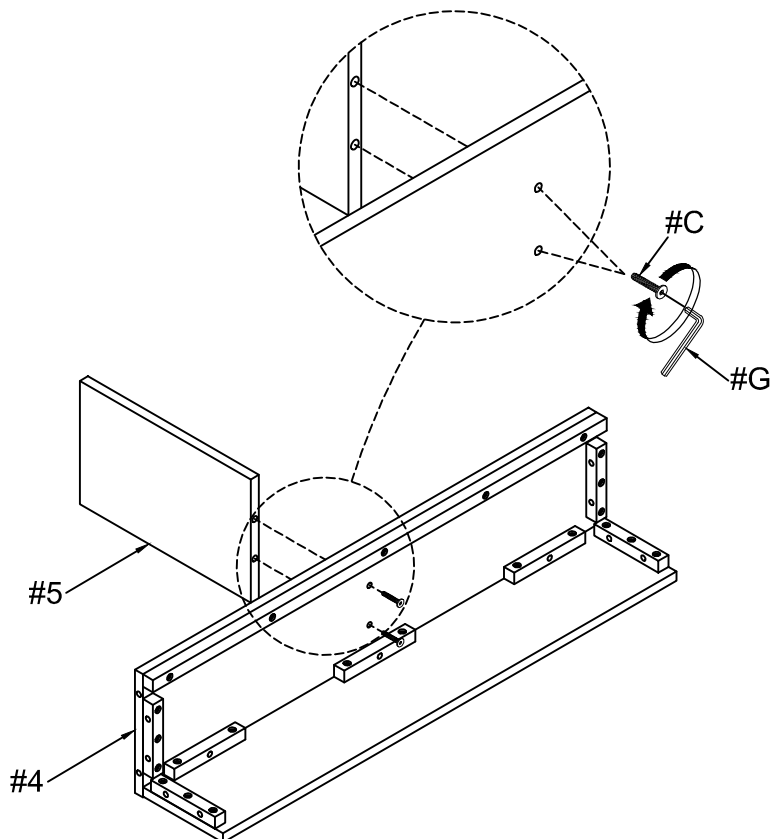
Align bottom shelf (#3) to the holes of the middle shelf (#4), then secure by using bolts (#C).

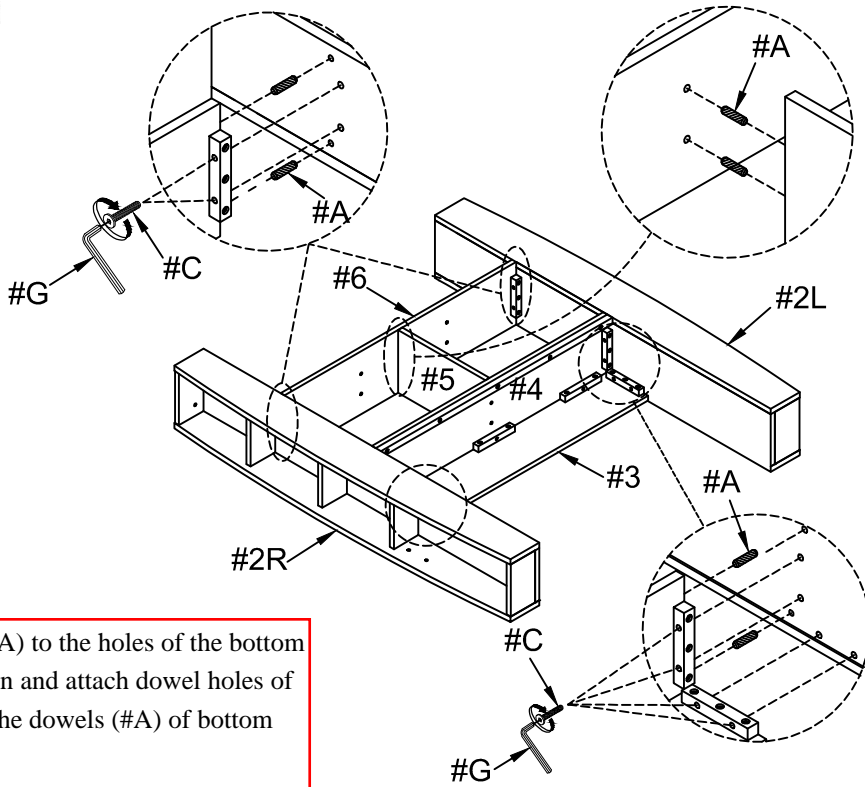
Align bottom shelf (#5) to the holes of the middle shelf (#4), then secure by using bolts (#C).

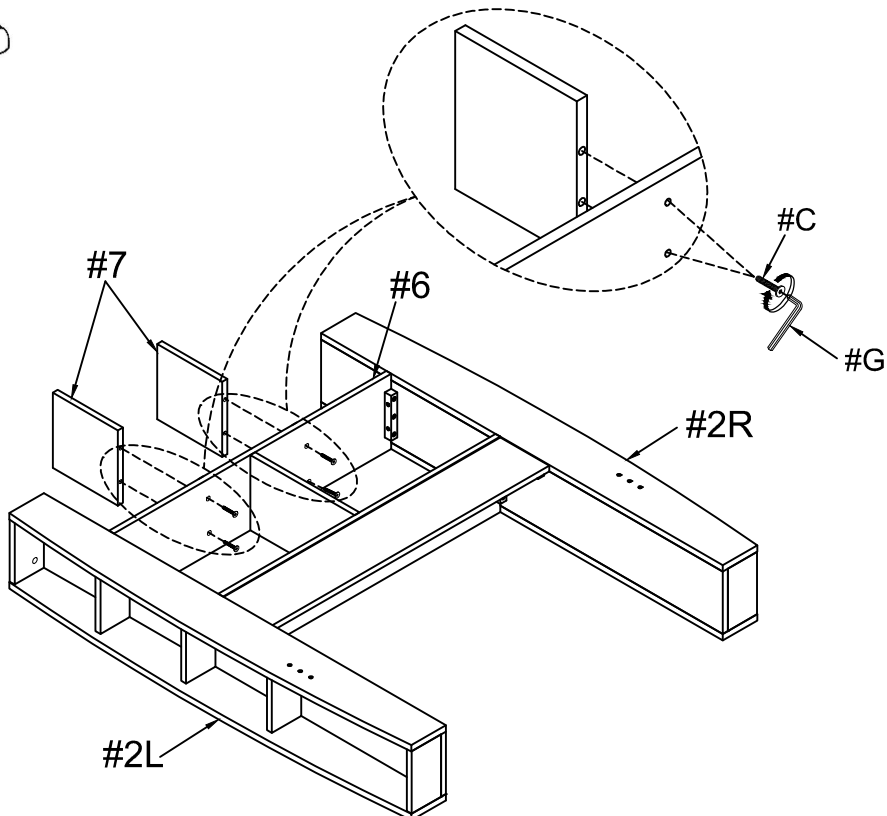

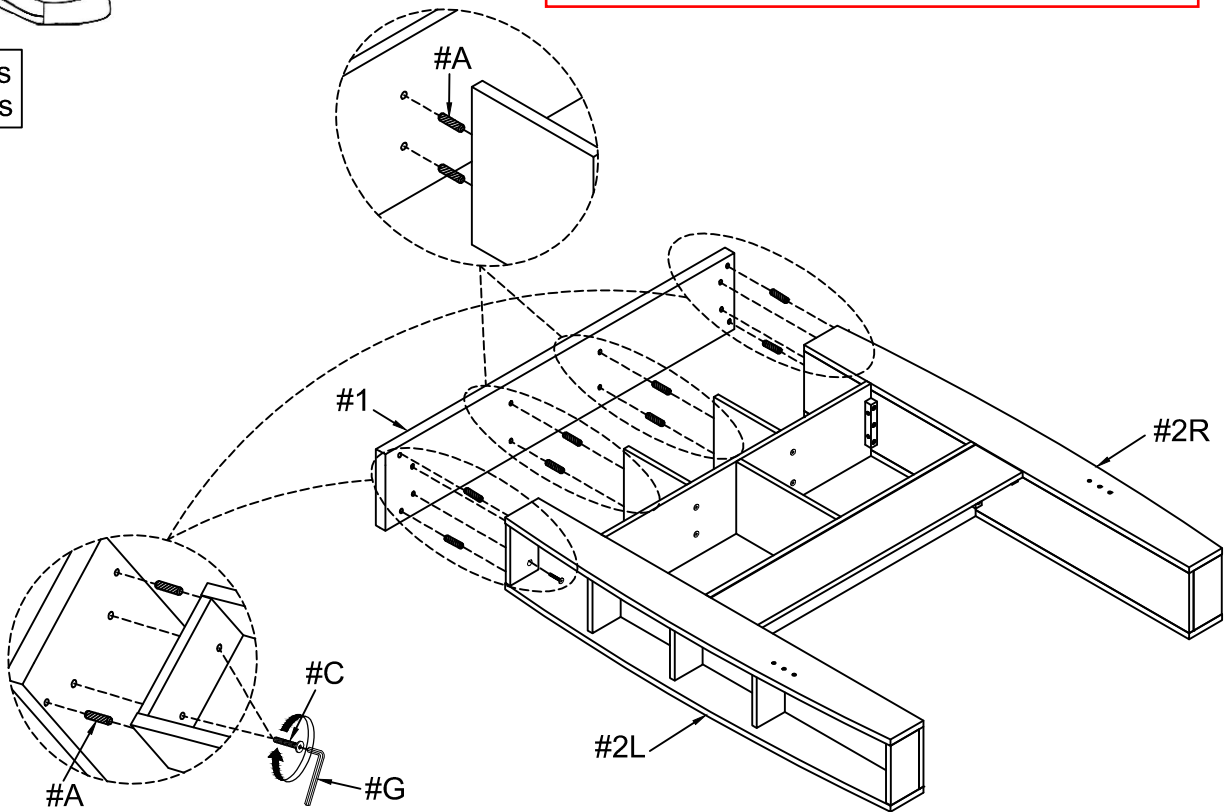
Align upper panel (#7) to the holes of the upper shelf (#6). Secure by using bolts (#C).





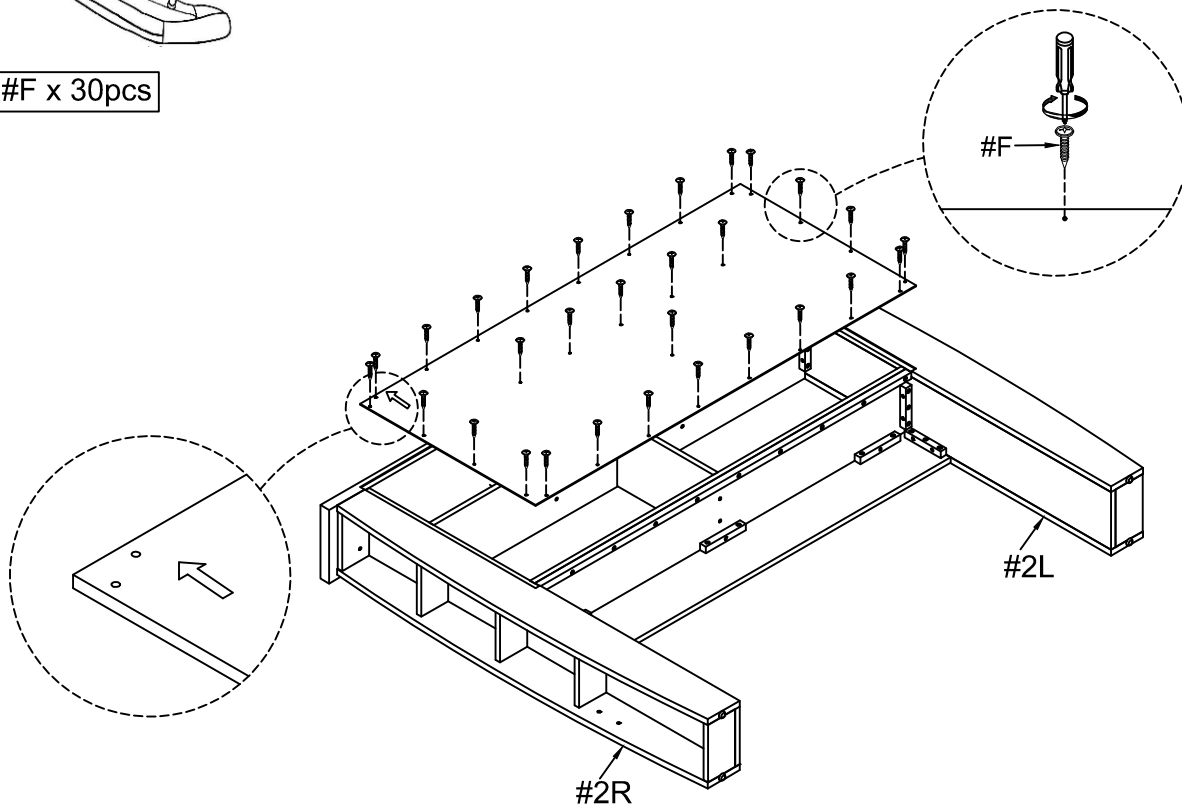
Attach dowels (#A) to the holes of headboard top panel (#1), then align top panel (#1) to the holes of the headboard base. Secure by using bolts (#C).

Align back panel (#8) to the back of the headboard. Secure by using screws (#F).

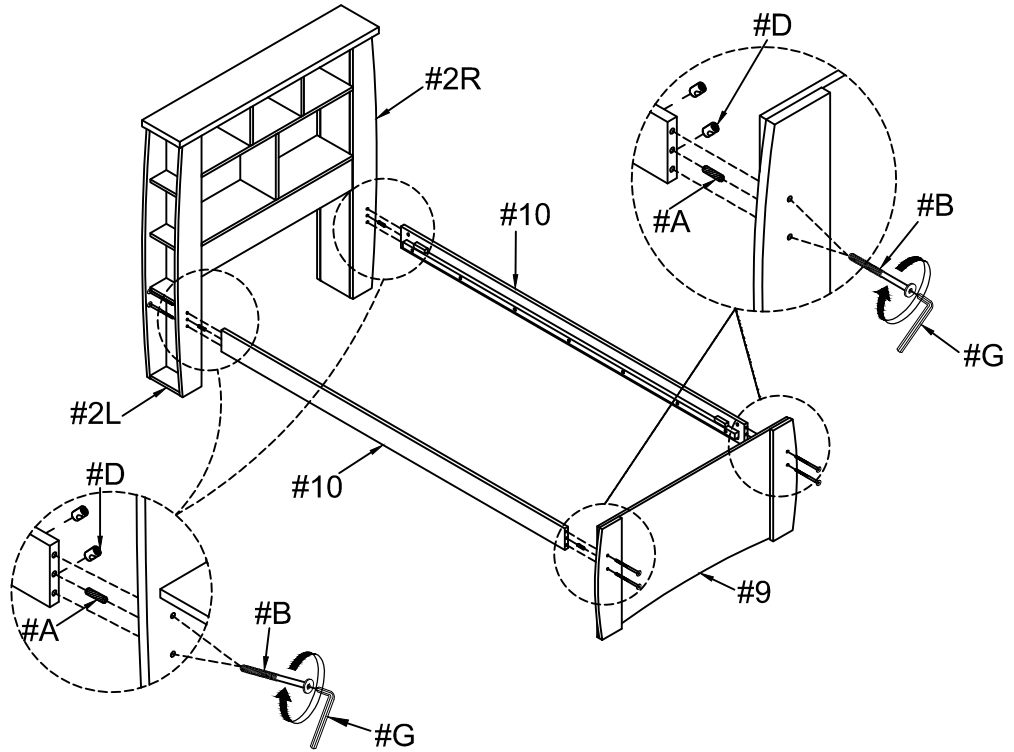

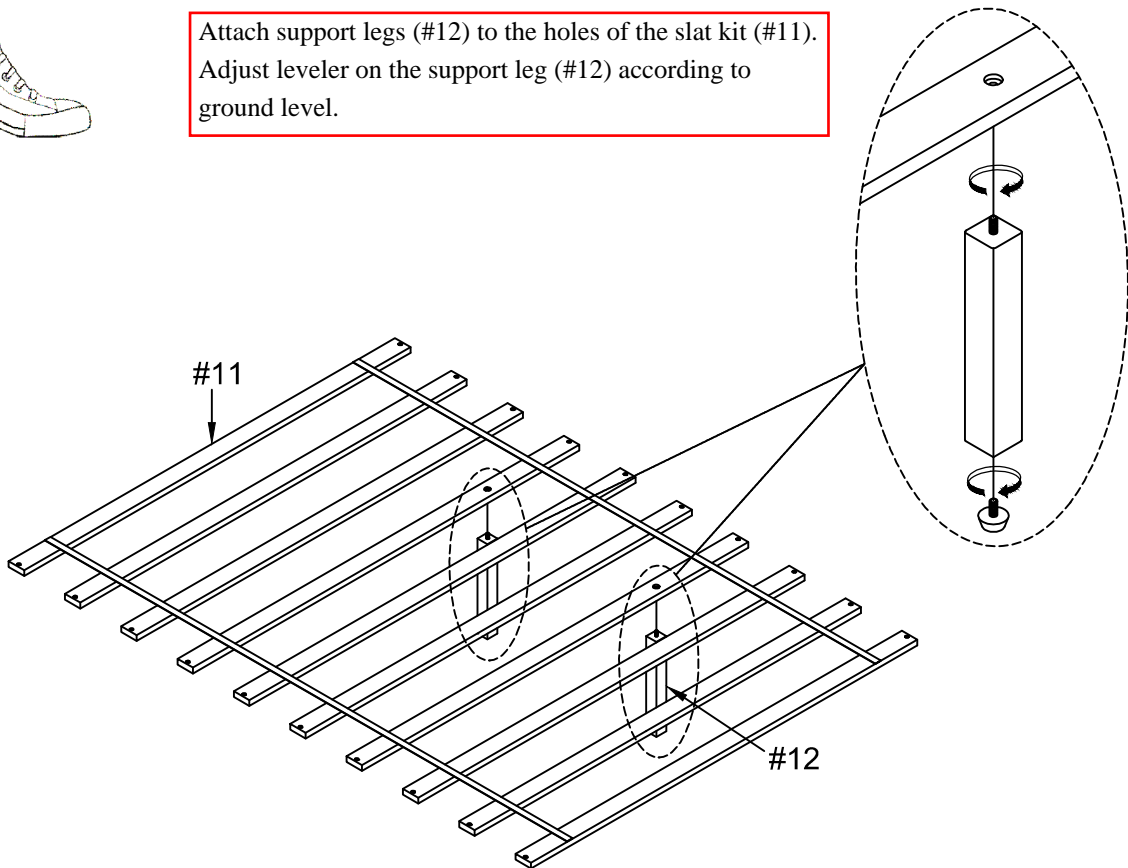


Attach dowel (#A) to the middle hole of the side rails (#10). Align side rails (#10) to the holes of the headboard legs (#2R/L) and footboard (#9). Insert barrel nuts (#D) to the holes of the side rails (#10), then secure by using bolts (#B) onto barrel nuts (#D).

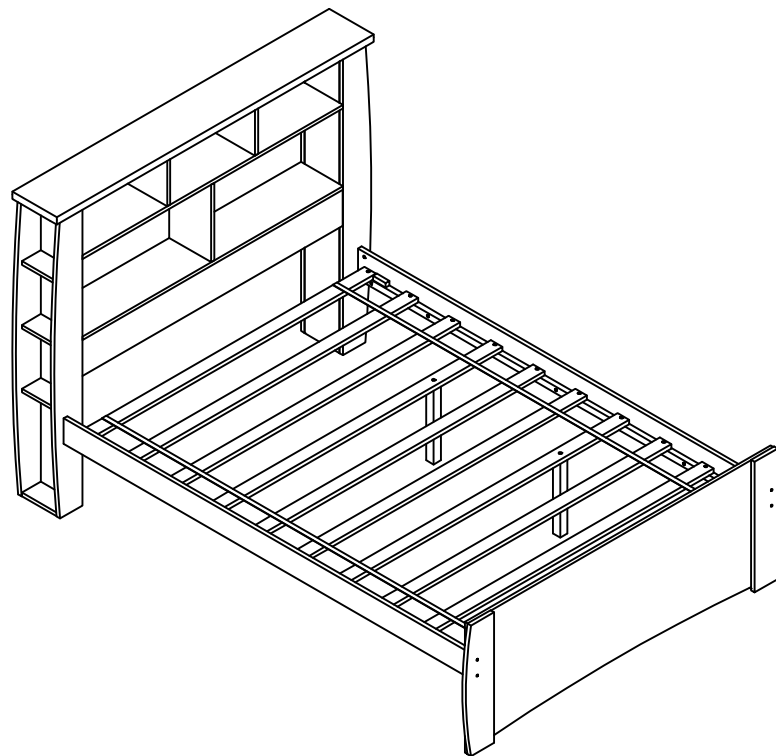
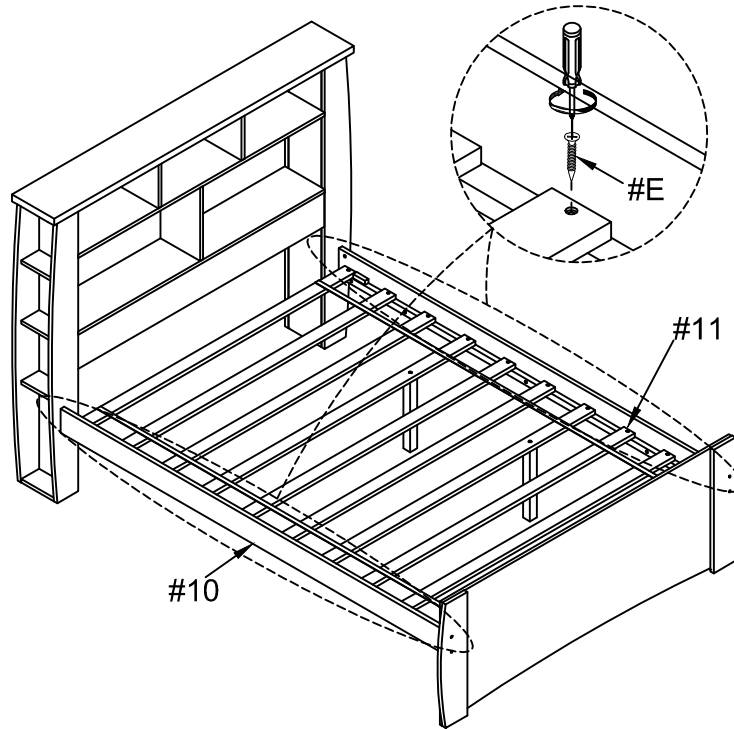
Attach support legs (#12) to the holes of the slat kit (#11). Adjust leveler on the support leg (#12) according to ground level.





Align slat kit (#11) to the side rails (#10), then secure by using screws (#E).
